yes, my favorite activity was when we were at tesla's house, that was very interesting

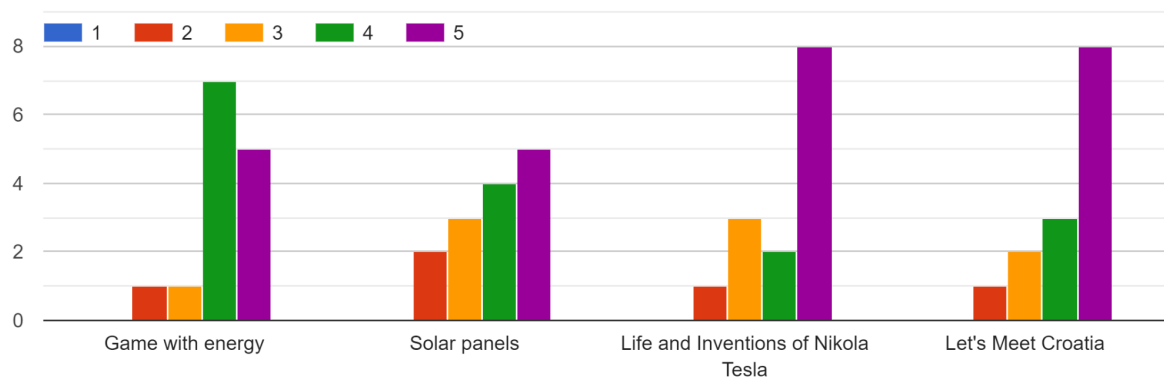
Yes, I did. My favorite activity was visiting the Memorial Center "Nikola Tesla"

Visiting the Tesla Museum in Zagreb was one of the best parts of the trip.

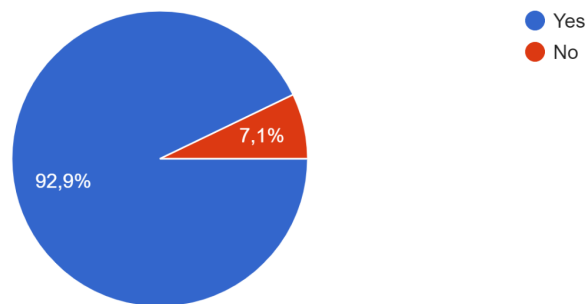
the visit to Zagreb

the museums were very interesting, they were also relevant

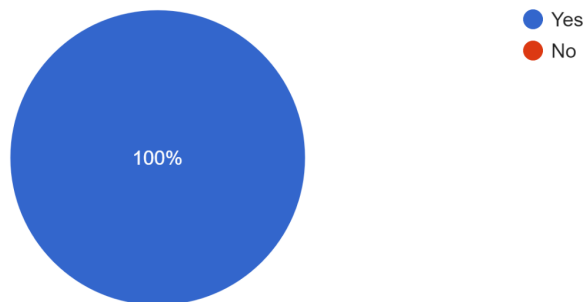
Yes, it was interesting to visit the museum and get a glimpse of what Tesla has done for humanity.

TESLA museum in Zagreb would have been enough, Smiljan was superfluous:

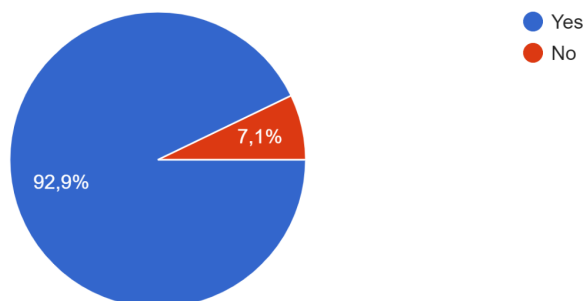
7. Did you through this mobility become more aware of the work and role of the scientist and inventor Nikola Tesla?

i have learnt new things about Nikola tesla and about the croatian everyday life

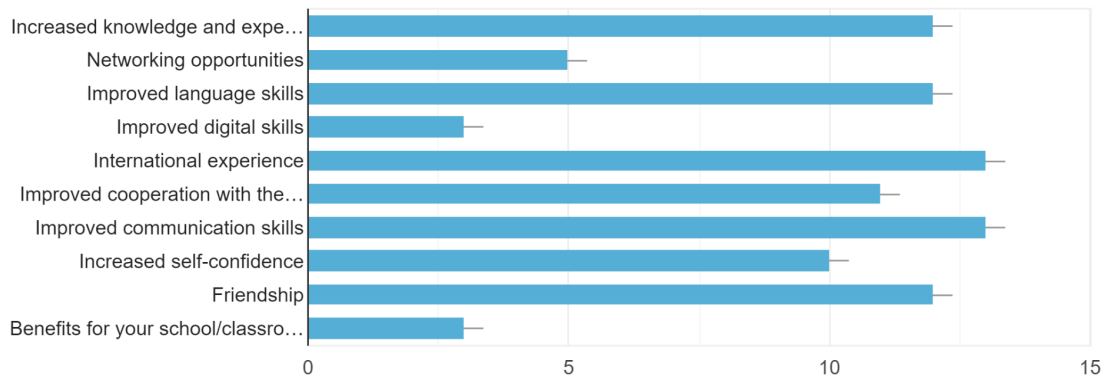
I have learned a lot of things about renewable energy sources , about Tesla and different cultures around the world

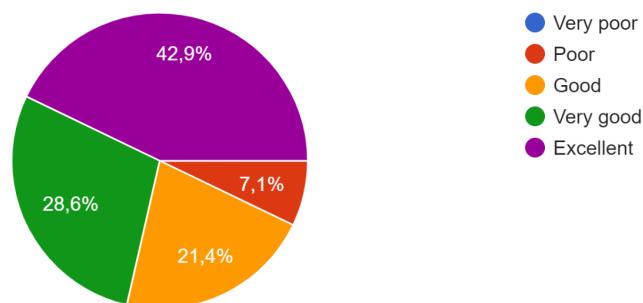
10. In your view, what were the outcomes of your mobility?
